



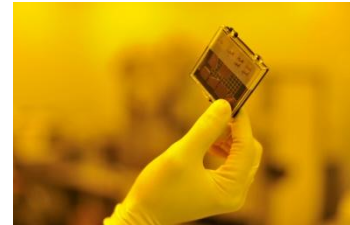
## Nano and Microtechnologies Company mission in Grenoble 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> April 2011

### Minatec

**Grenoble**, often called the French “Silicon Valley”, benefits from a rich network in nanotechnologies with the presence of big industrial groups (STMicroelectronics, Schneider Electric), a large number of SMEs, and numerous academic laboratories (CEA-LETI, INRIA, CEA-LITEN, G2Elab, LEPMI).

**Minatec** (initially called the **Micro** and **Nanotechnology** Innovation Centre) is a European research centre focused on nano and microtechnologies in Grenoble. Launched in 2006, the MINATEC innovation campus offers 20-hectares and 10,000 square meters of clean room space. It is a privileged place where 2,400 researchers, 1,200 students, and 600 technology transfer experts on a state-of-the-art work together. All the nano and microtechnologies sectors are covered: MEMS, micro and nanobiology, sensors, photonics...

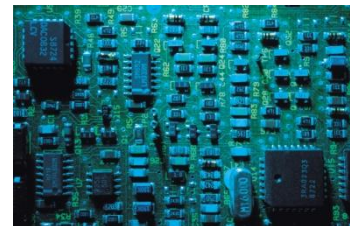

### Minalogic

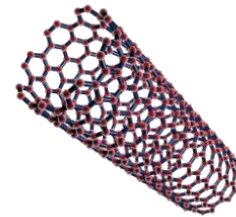
